

PEOPLES' SOCIAL SECURITY GUARANTEE ACT

Proposed by the American Federation of Senior Citizens

Wherein, past sessions of Congress have proposed legislation to protect Social Security benefits but that legislation has never been enacted, the American people are proposing more comprehensive legislation be drafted and immediately enacted by the 112th Congress.

With a skyrocketing deficit, the Social Security program operating in the red and the Social Security Trust Fund drained, it is clear that the 112th Congress must take action to reform Social Security. That action cannot and must not include the elimination of COLA benefits, raising the retirement age, tax increases or the elimination of the program altogether.

- Guarantee the retirement age will remain at 65;
- Guarantee COLA increases proportional to the actual cost of living for seniors;
